## AS A QUICK BREAK DEGREASER

**Cyndan CITRASOLVE** is a natural based quick break degreaser suitable for use in all quick break applications such as plate separators and other types of grease and waste water traps. It can be used in most industries to remove wet grease, heavy oil stains, tar, waxes and inks.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Spray or brush Cyndan Citrasolve on to the surface to be cleaned, allow it to penetrate the soiled area and rinse off with hot or cold water.

Cyndan Citrasolve is mild to all painted surfaces, but as will all degreasers, it is highly recommended that a trial be carried out on an inconspicuous area to test surface compatibility.

## AS AN ELECTRICAL SOLVENT

**Cyndan Citrasolve** is an ideal quick dry electrical solvent that can be used to dewater and degrease all electrical equipment safely. It has been tested to AS1716 to have a Dielectric strength of 8 kv.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Spray or brush the area to be cleaned and allow to air dry, a low pressure air hose may be used to assist drying. Do not start electrical equipment until Cyndan Citrasolve has evaporated. Cyndan Citrasolve is compatible with most varnishes and epoxies used in the electrical industry. It is advised that with all degreasers a test sample should be tried on an inconspicuous section to assess surface compatibility.

Other applications include generators, thermostats, switches, timers and mechanical telephone switching equipment. It will leave no residue although it evaporates slowly. Cyndan Citrasolve is a solubilizing solvent for sticky and wax residues. e.g. Latex based rubber, carpet adhesives, sticky back labels, printers ink, chewing gum on non porous surfaces and carpet.

### SAFETY DIRECTIONS:

Read MSDS before using this product. Do not use near naked flame. Use in well ventilated area with appropriate safety equipment.

### FIRST AID:
