## Biodegradability of Econo 101

We have investigated the ingredients of Econo 101 to determine the biodegradability of this product. The results are discussed below.

Econo 101 contains sodium hydroxide, sodium gluconate and phosphated surfactant.

We can advise that sodium gluconate and phosphated surfactant may be described as biodegradable, and that the claim may be readily supported. Sodium hydroxide, being non-carbon based can not be biodegraded (as indeed water can not), but is readily neutralised and diluted and so does not constitute a long term environmental hazard.

Further details may be seen on the MSDS if necessary.
