## GRAFFITI SHIELD PART A

CYNDAN\* GRAFFITI SHIELD is an acrylic copolymer solution designed to resist permanent penetration of Graffiti markings. In addition the CYNDAN\* GRAFFITI SHIELD has been formulated to allow the removal of these undesirable markings without breaking down under the chemical cleaning agents. This provides a long lasting durable finish which results in a superior economy. CYNDAN\* GRAFFITI SHIELD is a clear coating and may be applied over masonry and painted surfaces, timber, paper, tiles, terrazzo and metal.

### DIRECTIONS:

During the application of the Shield the user has a pot life of approximately 60 mins, depending on the temperature. This figure of 60 minutes is calculated at 20 degrees C. The coating is normally touch dry within 4 hours and fully cured after several days. An approximate coverage to be expected is 10 square metres per litre. One coat is normally sufficient. Several coats may be applied, however the second application cannot be applied until 4 hours has elapsed since the first coat, and no later than 24 hours.

Add Part B to the drum of Part A. Mix thoroughly and begin application. Apply by brush. Clean equipment with Xylene. Once cured the graffiti may be removed with CYNDAN\* REFUSAL, CYNDAN\* GRAFFITI REMOVER or CYNDAN\* GREEN SOLVE. As supplied Part A and Part B are pre-measured and should be mixed together and used as one batch. However, if smaller quantities are required the user may mix any amount of Part A with a solution of Part B. The amount of Part B required must not be more or less than 28% of the Part A which is to be mixed. If left open to the air or reopened too many times Part B will set due to moisture in the air.

**SAFETY:** Avoid contact with eyes.
