Paint Stripping Formula

DIRECTIONS:

Apply CYNDAN* ZIP STRIP liberally with a brush, to the area to be stripped. Ensure the entire surface is covered. The amount of time required for entire stripping will depend on the number of coats to be removed. 10 minutes is usually sufficient. Once the old coatings have blistered, simply rinse the surface with water or scrape the deposits away. Be cautious on synthetics such as lino, etc. Testing should always precede application to gauge reaction.

SAFETY:

Corrosive. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Wear protective clothing, gloves and eye protection.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting, give a glass of water and seek medical attention. Contact the Poisons Information Centre (13 11 26 Australia; 0800 764 766 New Zealand). If in eyes, hold eyelids open and flush with water for at least 15 minutes. If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and rinse for 15 minutes with soap and water. Ensure clothing is washed thoroughly before using again.
